Entry Fee: Cost is **\$180.00** per player. The fee includes entry, cart use for all tournament play even if a player decides to walk (see note below), range balls, tee gifts, prizes, breakfast each day, competitors' barbecue on Monday, and hors d'oeuvres at the awards ceremony on Wednesday, July 20. No refunds will be given for withdrawal after July 1, 2011.

Note: Carts are included in the entry fee for all tournament play even if the player walks with or without caddie. A maximum of two carts per group will be allowed. A caddie cart fee will be assessed if the caddie rides in cart during the tournament. No pull/push carts will be allowed during this competition.

Prize Structure: Universal Pro Shop Award Certificates will be given for the top 20 gross prizes and 3 daily net prizes. These certificates must be redeemed by October 1, 2011 and may be used at any New England pro shop.

Practice Round: Only competitors will be allowed to play a practice round which will be available any time after 2 pm on Sunday, July 17 or prior to the tournament by calling the Golf Shop at 860-229-6100. The cost of a practice round is payable in cash only and will cost \$30 including cart.

Eligibility: A contestant may be any amateur woman golfer who has a USGA handicap index of 17.4 or below, who is an active member of one of the NEWGA member state associations and is a legal resident of one of the six New England states. NEWGA associations may invite non-members who are residents of their state and have a handicap index that meets the entry requirements. A Junior is any girl who is a resident of her respective state and has not reached her 19th birthday by the opening day of the tournament. A Junior of 18 years of age is eligible *only* if she has not yet begun her first semester of college. A Junior does not have to be a member of a NEWGA member club, but must have a USGA handicap index of 17.4 or below. Parents and guardians are NOT allowed to caddie for Juniors. Seniors must be 50 years old and Legends must be 65 years old by the opening day of the tournament.

Tournament Info: Each state has a quota of 18 players. The total field will be 108 players for 36 holes and then cut to the 70 (low score) players (including ties) for the final round of play including anyone within ten shots of the leader in the player's respective category. Players are chosen based on lowest handicap by index as of USGA Handicap Revision effective June 15, 2011. A "Wait List" for greater than 18 applicants from a state is created by handicap index for each state after all states have entered their player lists. If a state is unable to fill its allotted positions, the unused positions will be divided equally among the states that have a waiting list. The use of distance measuring devices will be allowed during this Championship by local rule.
